Summary of purpose and scope of report

The purpose of this report is to update the Governing Body on the progress to date in delivering the STP and draws out key highlights from recent months.

Two key STP workshops have been held in the first stage of agreeing our priorities for STP focus. The first was with the Clinical Board to consider areas for clinical focus at an STP level. The second workshop was with the Clinical Board and Health Programme Board collectively (both clinical and managerial leaders from across the STP), to explore how we best work collectively and where we focus, in order to ensure maximum benefit for our residents.

In light of the above discussions and experience of working as an STP over the last 18 months, we are also reviewing the STP governance structure and how this links in with the governance of our statutory organisations. These draft proposals will be developed with constituent organisations in the coming months.

It would be helpful to note that format of this report will change going forward.
